# COMMITMENT




The church set out on June 14<sup>th</sup> to knock on a large portion of homes in downtown Beckley (starting from the intersection of Kanawha Street and Robert C Byrd Drive south to Kanawha Street and Eisenhower Drive). Our church members have been faithful to give out an average of 314 John and Romans per week. From June 14<sup>th</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup> we have handed out a total of 3,000 John and Romans. We now have a total of 50 missionaries that we support on a monthly basis. Praise the Lord for the opportunity God has given our church to *preach the Gospel to the Regions Beyond*. Most of the missionaries we support (45) are already on the field. Only five are still on deputation. Of the fifty missionaries, 36 are actually church planters, 14 are mission agencies or support groups. We had the privilege to travel to Michigan and pick up a press, folder, and staplers for Venezuela. They are now crated and ready to be shipped. Pray that these pieces will be used greatly to see souls saved in the country of Venezuela!

Please keep my wife, Kimberly, in your prayers. She has had a real battle this summer. Kim has had ulcerative colitis for the past sixteen years, but this June it greatly worsened. After sixteen days in the hospital, it was discovered that she also has celiac disease (wheat gluten intolerable). Ten days later, the pain was so severe that we went back to the hospital. This time for only five days. The chemotherapy they had given her created an acute case of pancreatic attack. Kimberly is a vital part of our family and ministry. ### Better to Serve the Egyptians?

*"... For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness."* Exodus 14:12

Every Christian faces troubles. It is something that each believer has dealt with, and will deal with, throughout their walk with the Lord. The truth of the matter is this, the trials of life are coming. Either you are in a trial, coming out of a trial, or heading into a trial (Job 5:7, 14:1). Troubles and problems are what we think we have more of than anyone else; they are part of life.

In Exodus chapter 14, we find the Hebrew children facing a great trial. Pharaoh, king of Egypt, was pursuing after them with "six hundred chosen chariots, ... and captains over every one of them" (vs. 7). The Hebrews had no place to turn or hide. It seemed that they were "entangled in the land" (vs. 3). We often find ourselves in the same situations. The world, the flesh, and the Devil breathing down our necks and seemingly nowhere to go.

What are our answers and our reactions to these situations? Far too many times we answer the same way the Hebrews did; "For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness" (vs. 12). This was the first trial these people had faced since God had delivered them from Egyptian bondage. And yet, at the first difficulty they wanted to retreat. They felt that it would be better for them and their families to toil gathering straw, labour making bricks, and be under the cruel hand of the Egyptian taskmasters in slavery than to be faced with the trouble at hand.

Dear Christian, remember this, IT IS NEVER BETTER BACK IN EGYPT! The Lord had caused them to turn and encamp in that exact spot (vs. 2). He had led them that exact way in order to prove Himself to them. There are times in the Christian life where Moses' exhortation of "Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, ..." (vs. 13) would appear to be impossible. However, to stand still and wait on the LORD is always a right decision.

The work of God is always moving forward. Sometimes we must stand still in order to move forward, but we can never move forward when we go back "to serve the Egyptians"! May the LORD help each of us to "continue" and never turn back.
